CAMERON PARISH PORT CELEBRATES FERC APPROVAL OF VENTURE GLOBAL CP2 PROJECT

CAMERON PARISH – The Cameron Parish Port, Harbor and Terminal District wants to congratulate Venture Global on receiving project approval from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) on Calcasieu Pass 2 (CP2) which is proposed to be built in Cameron, Louisiana.

The Port applauds the FERC vote which followed a thorough project review process.

“Today, FERC has verified what the Cameron Parish Port has been saying all along. Venture Global has done their due diligence in accordance with the standards set for the project and will continue to do so,” said Cameron Parish Port Executive Director Kim Montie.

Port officials are encouraging the United States Department of Energy (DOE) to approve Venture Global’s CP2 application to export liquefied natural gas (LNG) to non-Free Trade Agreement countries. In January, President’s Biden’s Administration put a pause on the authorization process.

“FERC has approved the project and now it is time for the Biden Administration to lift the pause and put our Cameron Parish small businesses, prepared for this construction, project to work. Small businesses are the lifeblood of our community and this is such a critical time in their hurricane recovery process,” said Montie.

The Cameron Port supports the LNG industry which has been vital in the ongoing economic recovery of Cameron Parish. Venture Global CP2’s commitment to innovation and sustainability aligns closely with the Port of Cameron’s mission to support responsible energy development. The Port recognizes the strategic importance of this approval, which will contribute to strengthening the region's economic vitality and energy security.

“This is another step forward in our parish’s recovery process,” said Cameron Parish Port Commission President Howard Romero.
